IMPORTANT MESSAGE FROM MRS. DETTRA!!

The Leadership of Merritt Island Christian School is taking a proactive approach in the decision to pull the Perfect Attendance Award for the 2009 - 2010 school year. This is due to the emergence in our state of a strain of influenza, known as H1N1 Swine Flu. This decision will hopefully help parents in keeping their sick children at home, without the pressure of trying to make perfect attendance. Our goal is to ensure that our students are safe.

CONTINUED ILLNESS PREVENTION... EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY:

In order to adhere to our continuing efforts to be proactive against flu and other illnesses, students are NOT allowed to wear gloves, fingerless gloves or “sleeves” while at school. There is no effective way that those students can wash their hands or use hand sanitizer on a regular basis. Thank you for helping us in this matter.

ATTENTION PARENTS! SWINE FLU UPDATE AND HOW YOU CAN HELP PREVENT THE SPREAD OF THIS FLU

Dear Parent,

As you may know, flu can be easily spread from person to person. Therefore, we are taking steps to reduce the spread of flu in Merritt Island Christian School. We want to keep the school open to students and functioning in a normal manner during this flu season. **But, we need your help to do this.**

We are working closely with the Florida Department of Health to monitor flu conditions and make decisions about the best steps to take concerning schools. We will keep you updated with new information as it becomes available.

If the flu becomes more severe, we may take additional steps to prevent the spread such as:

- conducting active fever and flu symptom screening of students and staff as they arrive at school,
- making changes to increase the space between people such as moving desks farther apart and postponing class trips, and
- dismissing students from school for at least 7 days if they become sick.

For now we are doing everything we can to keep our school functioning as usual. Here are a few things you can do to help.

- **Teach your children to wash their hands** often with soap and water or an alcohol-based hand rub. You can set a good example by doing this yourself.
- **Teach your children not to share personal items** like drinks, food or unwashed utensils, and to cover their coughs and sneezes with tissues. Covering up their coughs

or sneezes using the elbow, arm or sleeve instead of the hand when a tissue is unavailable.

- **Know the signs and symptoms of the flu.** Symptoms of the flu include fever (100 degrees Fahrenheit, 37.8 degrees Celsius or greater), cough, sore throat, a runny or stuffy nose, body aches, headache, and feeling very tired. Some people may also vomit or have diarrhea.
- **Keep sick children at home** for at least 24 hours *after* they no longer have fever or do not have signs of fever, **without using fever-reducing drugs.** Keeping children with a fever at home will reduce the number of people who may get infected.
- **Do not send children to school if they are sick.** Any children who are determined to be sick while at school *will be sent home.*
- **Get plenty of rest.** Make sure your student is getting plenty of sleep. The young body requires rest to maintain a high level of resistance.

HAVE YOU UPDATED YOUR 24/7 ACCOUNT YET?

How does 24/7 differ from Edline? With Edline, MICS is keeping you current on school information. With 24/7, you are keeping MICS current on your family information.

24/7 is used on a daily basis by MICS staff to access student and family information such as phone numbers, emergency contacts, medical information, email addresses and other school related information. After September 1st, the only source MICS will use for your family's school related information is the 24/7 online program. It is very important you complete this profile and keep it updated as changes occur during the school year.

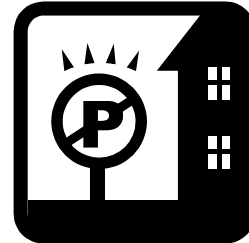

The note should state the DATE and TIME you wish to check them out. Students MUST be signed out through the main office before leaving campus.

FINGERPRINTING REQUIRED!

For our children's safety all parents need to be fingerprinted if: assisting teachers in the classroom, volunteering at MICS, attending field trips.

The cost of fingerprinting is \$50 (charged by Fla.

Department of Law Enforcement). Fingerprints are good

for five years. **If you would like to be fingerprinted you**

will need to fill out a fingerprint application, and turn it into the front office. Deanna Runyan will contact you for an appointment.
