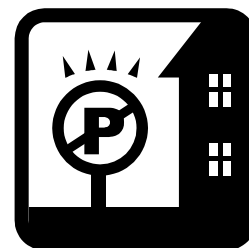

REMINDER PROCEDURE WHEN CHECKING YOUR CHILD OUT OF SCHOOL DURING SCHOOL TIME

Please remember if you are checking your child out of school during the school day to please SEND A NOTE WITH THEM so they may be dismissed from class at the appropriate time. The note should state the DATE and TIME you wish to check them out. Students MUST be signed out through the main office before leaving campus.

FINGERPRINTING REQUIRED!

For our children's safety all parents need to be fingerprinted if: assisting teachers in the classroom, volunteering at MICS, attending field trips.

The cost of fingerprinting is \$50 (charged by Fla.

Department of Law Enforcement). Fingerprints are good

for five years. **If you would like to be fingerprinted you**

will need to fill out a fingerprint application, and turn it into the front office. Deanna Runyan will contact you for an appointment.

Where to find codes:

Fridge pack = inside pull away cardboard

Case packs = inside pull away cardboard

Plastic wrapped Multi-packs = on bottom of plastic wrap (under shaded section)

Individual bottles (all sizes not sold in packs) = underneath the lid
